## Seizures



□ Confirm student's name
□ Confirm location
$\hfill\square$ Grab seizure kit (blanket, pillow, stop watch, gloves, demographic list, Health plan and medication)
□ Clear room (remove any objects that the student may hit his head with)
☐ Time the seizure with a stop watch
<ul> <li>Check Health Plan instructions for when medication is required</li> </ul>
□ Turn student on side
Don't put anything in mouth
Don't hold down
Remove glasses
Loosen tight clothing
☐ Cushion head (with pillow, jacket, sweater, etc. to prevent head trauma)
□ Cover student with blanket for privacy reasons
<ul> <li>All students with rectal medication should be covered when administering medication</li> </ul>
Student is wearing a dress, skirt etc.
□ Call 911
□ Call parent
<ul> <li>Remind parent that 911 has been called(school policy)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>If parent does not answer; call the emergency contact in file</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Parent must arrive to school within 10- 15 mins</li> </ul>
$\square$ Have the following information ready for the EMT
How long seizure lasted

• How many seizures the student had if more than one seizure

The time in between seizures if more than one seizure

• Demographic list

□ CMA, medical designee, front office or teacher must remain with student until 911 is dismissed
<ul> <li>If parent has not arrived a staff member should accompany student to the hospital (you may drive your own car unless paramedics request otherwise.</li> </ul>
□ Complete Injury Report
□ Enter Incident in ESP
☐ Make sure seizure kit is returned to the clinic (Print new demographic list, replenish any medical supplies)
